RULES FOR ADMISSION

B. A. Part - I and B. Com. Part - I

- 1) A student passing H. S. C. Examination conducted by the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination is eligible for admission to the First year of the senior college in Arts / Commerce.
- 2) The Students to be admitted will be required to submit the <u>ORIGINAL</u> marksheet of the H. S. C. Examination with two xeroxed copy thereof duly attested.
- 3) Two I-card size photographs (Colour) shall be submitted to the office at the time of admission.
- 4) The application of an Overseas students for admission to the College will be entertained only if he / she produces an Original Qualifying Certificate and a Provisional Eligibility Certificate from Shivaji University and / or the Board. The Original Qualifying Certificates shall never be returned after graduation.

5) 80% attendance in the class is mandatory.

- 6) Appearing for all Tests & Practice examination is compulsory.
- 7) Breach of college discipline will incite strict action in the form of cancellation of admission.
- 8) Regularly irregular students will not be allowed to fill the examination form.
- 9) Timely submission of assignments & projects is compulsory.
- 10) Presence of parents is compulsory for Parent Teacher Meet.
- 11) Active participation in curricular & Co-curricular activity is must.

TERMS AND ATTENDANCE

- 1. The Academic Year begins From 15/06/2024.
 The 'Winter & Summer Vacations' will be as per University Rules.
- 2. One day's attendance means attendance at all lectures, tests, tutorials etc. prescribed for that day.
- 3. Roll numbers will be called out at each lecture and absence for one lecture is treated as absence for the whole day. Such absent students are liable to be penalised.
- 4. Students who remain absent from the college despite warnings will be removed from the college roll at the end of each term.
- 5. Students wishing to be absent from the college on any day or days must apply for leave in advance, to the Principal.
- 6. Students wishing to be absent without such proper leave from the College are liable to be Penalised.
- 7. In case of illness, students must apply for leave as soon as possible with a Medical Certificate attached to the leave note available in the office and must report themselves to the College Office immediately after illness.
- 8. In order to keep a term at the College a student must complete to the satisfaction of the Principal, the course of study including lectures, tutorials, tests etc. at the College as prescribed for the term and for the class to which the students belong. Out of 180 working days 75% attendance is compulsory.
- 9. Student are required to be present in the College on the appointed day after examination, holidays or vacations. Those who remain absent without valid reasons are liable to be penalised or removed from the College roll.
- 10. The Term Fees must be paid in full immediately on admission. Students who do not pay their fees on the prescribed days are liable to pay a fine or their names may be struck off from the College roll.
- 11. Attending Monthly Tests, Terminal Examination, Practice Examinations, Socratic Club and other College activities is compulsory. Failure to comply with this regulations shall be penalised.
- 12. Any Student belonging to SC/ST/NT/DTNT/VJNT, etc. caste may attach the copy of valid Caste Certificate at the time of admission.

No refund is allowed to a student who leaves the college after 10 days from the commencement of the term.
